The Automated Management package is like adding a manager to your staff who never goes home.

The Automated Management Package (AMP) includes:

- **Custom Reports (CR)** – is a collection of features that allow you to define up to 32,000 specific selection patterns so reports can be generated consistently without re-selecting the reporting criteria. Each category of report – Transaction, Inventory and Other – can assign nine on-screen buttons for one-click reporting of your most common reports.

- **Email Generation (EG)** – is a collection of features that allow you to directly email any report with accompanying notes and attached files within **ContainerTRACKER**<sup>®</sup>. The Email Generation package includes the Report Exporting feature. The Email Generation feature is required for the Triggers feature to email reports or messages.

- **Inventory Alarms (IAM)** – is a collection of features that allow you to define inventory alarms and create custom alarm messages for each inventory location (a combination of an item with a location or status). Each inventory location can have four possible hierarchical alarms – Low, A, B, and High. Each alarm generates a standard message by default. You can define custom messages for any specific alarm. The alarms provide an on-screen message when a move results in inventory that is below or above the alarms.
