

**How To Purchase / Register *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup>**

Purchasing *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup> is an eight step process, the steps are;

1. Install the *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup> Demo. Even when you don't need to run the demo, installing the demo allows you to start the process of purchasing *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup>.
2. Run the *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup> Demo and select 'Purchase *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup>' from the 'Purchase CT Menu in the menu bar at the top of the Main screen. This will display a form with the title 'Product Registration/Purchase - Enter Customer Information'.
3. Fill in the required registration information (yellow fields).
4. Click on the 'Save the Entered Info.' button. This will create three files in the *CTInstall*\ExportReports directory. These files will have names like  
SIO-100105-150630.pdf  
RegInfoTestingCom.txt  
Testin100105-150659.txt

The six digit numbers are the date in 'mmddy' format and the time 'hhmmss' 24 hour clock format. They represent the time and the date the registration file was entered. The 'TestingCom' will be replaced with the first 10 characters of the company name you entered; 'Testin' will be the first six characters of the company name you entered. When these files are created within *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup> the program displays their names so you can write them down.

5. Email these files to *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup> at [register@iigsystems.com](mailto:register@iigsystems.com). You can mail them from your regular email or you can setup email within *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup>. If you set up the email client within *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup> it will automatically attach the files to the email message. If you use other email, you will have to attach the files you created manually.
6. IIG will email an 'initial registration patch file' back to you at the email address you specified when entering the registration information. The patch file will have a name like PF1003CN0002PX100405.pch. The 'PF' identifies it as a patch file. The number following the 'PF' is the patch file number. The next eight characters are an encrypted string that ensures that the patch is run on your machine. The last six digits are the patch file expiration date in the 'mmddy' date format.

Each patch file is created for a specific installation. It is dates and has an internal counter that prevents it from being run more than once. Changing the file name will cause the patch to fail.

7. Run the 'Initial Registration Patch File' by selecting 'Run Initial Registration Patch' from the 'Purchase CT Menu in the menu bar at the top of the Main screen. When you run the patch file it will automatically create a username and password. Write these down.
8. Exit from *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup>. When you restart *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup> login with the username and password you wrote down. This username will give you supervisory rights to the product so you can create other users and configure *Container*TRACKER<sup>®</sup>.
